## **Summary**

At the August 11, 2010 meeting, the Board directed staff to require permit applicants to indemnify the District on a case-by-case basis when the APCO determined it would be appropriate and to report back to the Board on each specific case. This report is to notify the Board that the District is processing the following application(s), for which the APCO has determined it is appropriate to require indemnification. The source has been notified of this requirement:

- Clark Pacific. ATCs C-19-152, C-20-63, and C-20-64 for modifications to the abrasive blasting operation and rubber molding process and a new permit welding operations. The permit actions include indemnifications because the facility is subject to offset requirements.
- Blessed Extracts, LLC. ATC C-20-75 for modifications to the cannabis extraction permit. The permit actions include indemnifications because this type of operation has significant public interest.
