Our Work

Rules and Compliance

Our Board of Directors adopts rules intended to protect our clean air without imposing unnecessary burdens on industry. The rules are enforced through the District's permitting process and compliance programs.

Permits

The District issues permits for industrial and commercial projects in its jurisdiction that have the potential to emit air pollution.

Incentives

The District seeks opportunities to leverage funding to reduce air pollution and make adoption of cleaner equipment costeffective for member of the community.

Land Use

The District's planning staff contributes to environmental review for local projects that could impact air quality and assists with initiatives intended to improve clean transportation mode share.

Public Awareness

The District works to affect behavior change by educating the public on the primary consumer-level sources of air pollution such as personal transportation and wood burning.
