Summary

At the August 11, 2010 meeting, the Board directed staff to require permit applicants to indemnify the District on a case-by-case basis when the APCO determined it would be appropriate and to report back to the Board on each specific case. This report is to notify the Board that the District is processing the following application(s), for which the APCO has determined it is appropriate to require indemnification. The source has been notified of this requirement:

- Pacific Coast Producers. ATC C-21-30 for installation of a new boiler. Due to the application triggering offset requirements.
- Innovative Environmental Solutions. ATC C-21-36 for installation of a soil vapor extraction unit to operate within 1,000 feet of a school. Due to the application triggering a school notice.
- City of Davis. ATC C-21-40 for modification of an emergency internal combustion engine to operate within 1,000 feet of a school. Due to the application triggering a school notice.
- Conduit Infrastructure Holding 1A, LLC. ATCs C-21-50 and C-21-51 for modification of stationary fuel storage tanks. Due to Conduit Infrastructure Holding 1A, LLC operating a Title V facility.
- Recology Hay Road. ATC C-21-60 for installation of an emergency internal combustion engine.
 Due to Recology Hay Road operating a Title V facility and the permit action triggering offset requirements.
