<u>Summary</u>

At the August 11, 2010 meeting, the Board directed staff to require permit applicants to indemnify the District on a case-by-case basis when the APCO determined it would be appropriate and to report back to the Board on each specific case. This report is to notify the Board that the District is processing the following application(s), for which the APCO has determined it is appropriate to require indemnification. The source has been notified of this requirement:

- Clark Pacific. ATCs C-21-61 and C-21-79 for installation of a portable coating process and a portable gel coating process. Due to the applications triggering offset requirements.
- University of California, Davis. ATCs C-21-88, C-21-92, C-21-93, and C-21-84 for installation of multiple gaseous-fired boilers. Due to the applications triggering offset requirements and University of California, Davis operating a Title V facility.
- Esparto Unified School District. ATC C-21-78 for installation of a gasoline dispensing facility to operate within 1,000 feet of a school. Due to the application triggering a school notice.
- First Baptist Church. ATC C-21-82 for installation of a diesel-powered internal combustion engine operating within 1,000 feet of a school. Due to the application triggering a school notice.
- Pacific Gas and Electric Company. ATC C-21-96 for installation of a natural gas-powered internal combustion engine to operate within 1,000 feet of a school. Due to the application triggering a school notice.
