At the August 11, 2010 meeting, the Board directed staff to require permit applicants to indemnify the District on a case-by-case basis when the APCO determined it would be appropriate and to report back to the Board on each specific case. This report is to notify the Board that the District is processing the following application(s), for which the APCO has determined it is appropriate to require indemnification. The source has been notified of this requirement:

- CalPeak Power Vaca Dixon, LLC. ATCs C-21-128 for modifying permits for a peaking power plant. Due to CalPeak Power Vaca Dixon, LLC operating a Title V facility.
- Northern Recycling, LLC. ATCs C-21-132 through C-21-138 for modifications to permits relocating a composting operation. Due to the applications potentially triggering offsets.
- G&A Holdings. ATC C-21-140 for permitting of a cannabis extraction process. Due to the proposed project being of significant public interest.
- Pacific Gas and Electric Company. ATCs C-21-145 through C-21-168 for permitting of 24
 emergency internal combustion engines to generate power during Public Safety Power Shutoff
 events. Due to the applicant have a negative compliance history and the project being of
 significant public interest.
- Yolo County General Services Department. ATC C-21-174 for permitting of an emergency internal combustion engine to operate within 1,000 feet of a school. Due to the application triggering a school notice.
