Deadline Extended for 2020 Clean Air Funds

(Davis, CA) – The Yolo-Solano Air Quality Management District (District) extended the application deadline for local projects for their 2020 Clean Air Funds program. The District acknowledges the constraints faced by so many due to COVID-19, school closures and stay-at-home orders. Committed to ensure opportunity and access to participate in this year’s program, the deadline for applications is now September 25, 2020 at 4:00 p.m.

The Clean Air Funds program seeks to encourage private businesses, non-profit organizations and public agencies to pursue cost-effective, impactful projects within the District designed to reduce pollution emissions from mobile sources through grant funding. Projects can be submitted in one of four categories:

- Clean Vehicle Technology
- Alternative Transportation
- Transit Services
- Public Education/Information

The District has awarded over \$2.5 million to fund projects in the last five years, including over \$150,000 last year to fund bicycle infrastructure and rack installation, EV charging and infrastructure replacement, and educational programs.

This year the District will award an estimated \$400,000 in projects within Yolo and Solano counties. Grants are awarded on a competitive basis by the District’s Board of Directors.
