Summary

At the August 11, 2010 meeting, the Board directed staff to require permit applicants to indemnify the District on a case-by-case basis when the APCO determined it would be appropriate and to report back to the Board on each specific case. This report is to notify the Board that the District is processing the following application(s), for which the APCO has determined it is appropriate to require indemnification. The source has been notified of this requirement:

- Yolo County General Services Department. ATC C-21-104 for permitting of an existing propane boiler operating within 1,000 feet of a school. Due to the application triggering a school notice.
- Woodland Joint Unified School District. ATC C-21-119 for permitting of plasma cutting operation to operate within 1,000 feet of a school. Due to the application triggering a school notice.
- Pacific Gas and Electric Company. ATC C-21-123 for permitting of an emergency internal combustion engine to operate within 1,000 feet of a school. Due to the application triggering a school notice.
