\$421,000 Available in Clean Air Fund Grants

(Davis, CA) – The Yolo-Solano Air Quality Management District (District) has opened the application period for the 2022 Clean Air Funds program. This annual grant program has \$421,000 available in funding for local projects that will reduce emissions from mobile sources of air pollution within the District. Grants are awarded on a competitive basis by the District's Board of Directors.

The deadline to apply is April 15, 2022, at 4:00 p.m. Applications are available at <u>https://www.ysaqmd.org/Apply2022CAF</u>.

The Clean Air Funds program seeks to encourage private businesses, non-profit organizations, and public agencies to pursue cost-effective, impactful projects designed to reduce pollution emissions from mobile sources within the District through grant funding. There are four qualifying project categories: Clean Vehicle Technology, Alternative Transportation, Transit Services and Public Education. Previous projects include bicycle infrastructure and rack installation, EV charging installation, clean vehicle fleet purchases and alternative transportation public outreach programs.
