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MASTER FEE SCHEDULE - Effective January 1, 2023

Rule 4.1 - Stationary Source Program

Stationary Source Program Rule 4.1 fee schedules are listed below. Rule 4.1 was Consumer Price Index (CPI) adjusted on July 1, 2022. Every applicant for an initial Authority to Construct (ATC) shall pay the filing fee in Section 307 (Schedule 1 through 8) of Rule 4.1, upon filing of the application. If you are unsure of which schedule applies, contact the District's Engineering Division. If the District determines it necessary, you will be notified that the application fees will be based on the actual hours spent at the time and materials rate in Section 307.10, in which case the filing fee serves as a deposit.

For PTO renewals, the permittee must pay the annual fee, indicated under the appropriate fee schedule (1 through 8), as well as pay emission fees as explained below under Section 302.2.

In addition, every holder of an Agricultural Engine Registration shall pay an annual registration renewal. Agricultural Engine Registration renewals are based on one hour of Time & Materials Rate as determined by Section 307.10 below.
