### **‘Don’t Light Tonight’ Advisory for Friday, December 8**

(Davis, CA) – A ‘Don’t Light Tonight’ Advisory is in effect from midnight to midnight on Friday, December 8, 2017. The District asks residents in Yolo County and the northeastern portion of Solano County that includes Dixon, Rio Vista and Vacaville to refrain from burning wood in their wood stove or fireplace to help reduce fine particulate pollution.

The Air Quality Index (AQI) is forecast to be 82 on Friday, which is Moderate with potential mild impacts for extremely sensitive groups. A strong upper-level ridge of high pressure will remain over California, reducing atmospheric mixing while light winds will limit pollutant dispersion. In addition, regional pollutants will carry over from previous days.
